PAUL CLEARY, GLEN DAVIS, VICTOR MASTRO
CHOSEN PREP SCHOOL PLAYERS OF YEAR
HONORED IN SILVERWOODS HALL OF FAME

Paul Cleary, Santa Ana Junior College end and blocking-back; Glen Davis, Bonita High School touchdown wizard; and Victor Mastro, hard-hitting Marshall High School back, have been chosen Southern California Players of the Year by members of All Southern California Board of Football -- composed of Al Bine, Los Angeles Examiner; George Main, Los Angeles Herald-Express; John Beekman, Los Angeles Daily News; John de la Vega, Los Angeles Times; Lowell Redelings, Hollywood Citizen-News, and Bill Schroeder, Helms Athletic Foundation.

Cleary, Davis and Mastro were truly the most brilliant players of their respective junior college and high school divisions.

Paul Cleary, 5-foot, 10-inch, 180-pound co-captain of the Santa Ana Junior College team, was chosen Southern California Junior College Player of the Year. Although Cleary did not gain the headlines given other players, members of All-Southern California Board of Football did not overlook his outstanding work throughout the season as a pass-catching end, (the early part of the year) and later as a blocking back. Coach Bill Cook found it necessary to shift Cleary to a blocking-back post in mid-season. Cleary continued to play a sparkling game at the blocking-back post, as he did at the end position. Paul scored 24 points during the season. He is in his second year at Santa Ana Junior College. It is not often that a blocking back is chosen for Player of the Year honors, but Cleary is one young man who deserves the honors which have been given to him. He's tops.

Glen Davis, brilliant Bonita High School (La Verne) touchdown maker, easily earned Player of the Year honors in Southern California High School C.I.F. ranks. Davis was one of the most sensational ball carriers ever seen in Southern California. He set what is believed to be a Southern California high school record for points scored in a season, tallying a total of 236 digits. Besides being an exceptional runner, Davis is a skilled forward pass expert. Glen was a threat every time he put his hands on the ball. He is a hard runner, shifty and fast.

In the South Pasadena game, a semi-final championship contest, Davis registered four touchdowns for Bonita via land and air, in the first half. Two of the scores were the result of his passes. With a minute to play in the first half, Davis fired a pass for a touchdown. The play was nullified because of a penalty. On the next play, Davis fired another pass for a touchdown. This play was also nullified because of a penalty. Bonita then tied a line play which failed. On the next play, as the gun barked, Davis tucked the pigskin to his bosom and romped on to a touchdown. 3 touchdowns in a minute of play, although only one was official, isn't a mediocre presentation. Glen Davis deserves to be rated with the greatest prep school backs in Southern California high school football history. Davis scored 5 touchdowns in the So. Calif. final, against Newport Harbor.

Victor Mastro, hard-running Marshall High School back, was head and shoulders above any other Los Angeles City high school back this year. He chatted up 110 points in 8 games, and made the scores in every way imaginable -- line smashing, open-field running, etc. Vic is an exceptionally hard hitter, but despite his weight of 200 pounds is able to put on swivel-hipped exhibitions. He passes well and kicks with the best of them. There probably wasn't a better line smasher in Southern California prep school ranks than Mastro. Mastro won his Player of the Year honors unanimously. Vic stands 5'10, and weighs 200. He is a senior.

Paul Cleary, Glen Davis, and Victor Mastro will be honored at Silverwoods Hall of Fame on Saturday morning, December 19th, at ten-thirty, during the All Southern California Board of Football program which is to be held at the Hall of Fame at that time. Cleary, Davis and Mastro will be presented with Helms Athletic Foundation medals, and will have their names engraved upon the Paul H. Helms Southern California Prep School Player of the Year trophy. Cleary, Davis and Mastro will also have the names placed upon the Hall of Fame plaque at Silverwoods Hall of Fame, and their photographs will be posted permanently in the Hall of Fame quarters. COMMENT: The 1942 All-Southern California C.I.F. is probably the highest scoring mythical all-star team ever mastered together in this district. The five backs accounted for a total of almost 500 points during the past season. Glen Davis, the sensational Bonita back, was the touchdown leader, registering over 200 points. The two ends, Bare and Hooks, via their pass-catching ability, contribute another 73 points to the high-scoring all-star unit.

It is needless to review the talents of the twelve boys selected for honors, for they were all tops in every department of play during the season.

Leon McLaughlin of Santa Monica was the only player to gain first-team All-Southern California honors for the second consecutive year, although Ted Bare, Chino end, was selected for 3rd team honors in 1941, while Harold Sheflin of Newport Harbor was accorded similar laurels.

COMMENT: The All-City team is a well-rounded aggregation. The ends are versatile. Hodge runs on end-arounds, receives passes and excels on defense, while Huston is a bear at blocking kicks and recovering fumbles. He's a regular ball hawk. Houston and Simons are powerful tackles, being the iron-man type. Both block and are strong on defense. Gazin and Mallicoat are splendid blockers, and hit hard. Their defensive play is also outstanding. Big Lee Roster is an exceptional pivot man. He is noted for his defensive work. He calls signals, and does a good job of it.

Mastro and Leon are hard runners, and despite their weight are good in the open field. Brown and Schneider are the speed-burners, featuring the swivel-hipped dashes. Cheek and Leon are splendid blockers, Cheek being particularly outstanding at the trade. Leon would do the kicking for the squad, and would also pass -- sharing the duties with Mastro, who also does some nifty kicking.
